

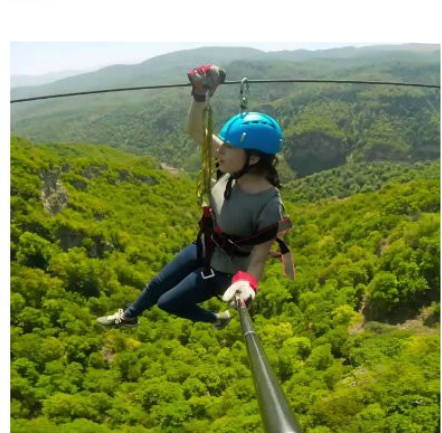


Tour: **Multi Adventure tour to Armenia**

Duration: 8 days / 7 nights

Characteristics: multi activity included : hiking, 4x4, horse - riding, zip-line, moto tour etc.

Suitable for small groups



BRIEF ITINERARY

Day 1. Departure from homeland

Day 2: CLASSICAL prg.- Arrival to Yerevan- City tour - Echimadzin - Garni - Ararat Brandy Factory

Day 3: JEEP TOUR - Yerevan-Hankavan-Aparan-Spitak-Trchkan fall-Gyumri

Day 4: HORSE RIDING & ZIP LINE - Yerevan - Sevan - Yenokavan

Day 5: HIKING - Yenokavan - Aragats - Amberd (if time permits)- Yerevan

Day 6: WINE TOUR: Yerevan - Khor Virap - Noravank - "Trinity Winery" - Yerevan

Day 7: MOTO TOUR

DESCRIPTIVE ITINERARY

Day 1. Departure from homeland

Day 2: **CLASSICAL** prg.- Arrival to Yerevan- City tour - Echimadzin - Garni - Ararat Brandy Factory
Yerevan

Arrival to Zvartnots international airport in Yerevan. Private transfer to hotel. Short rest or overnight.
Breakfast. Explore the capital of Armenia - Yerevan - the city older than Rome. Stop over Cascade monument for a panoramic view to the city. Drive to Echmiadzin - the religious center of Armenia.
Continue to Garni village and visit pagan temple of 1st cen. which is the only one survived among all CIS countries. Return back to Yerevan. Overnight in Yerevan.

Optional visit at legendary Ararat Brandy Factory.

Day 3: **JEEP TOUR** - Yerevan-Hankavan-Aparan-Spitak-Trchkan fall-Gyumri

Breakfast at the hotel. Heading to Hankavan, off-road driving up hill to Tsaghkunyats mountains range and drive down to Aparan reservoir, continue on asphalt road to Spitak, starting with a nice off road driving from Spitak to Trchkan Fall, the largest waterfall in Armenia. Driving to Gyumri on dirt road. Heading back to Yerevan. Overnight in Yerevan.

Total driving- 260 km, of which off-road driving- 35 km.

Day 4: **HORSE RIDING & ZIP LINE** - Yerevan - Sevan - Yenokavan

Breakfast at the hotel. Drive to lake Sevan which is worlds second highest and largest alpine freshwater lake. Visit the monasteries on the peninsula and have a beautiful view to the lake. Drive to Yenokavan

village and check in at a nice resort situated over the village on a plateau surrounded by the mountains. Horse – riding, mountain bike, fishing, trekking and zip-line are offered by the resort. But the place is suitable also for different evening activities like master classes, teambuilding and other entertainment options. Overnight at the resort.

Day 5: **HIKING** – Yenokavan – Aragats – Amberd (if time permits)- Yerevan
Breakfast at the hotel. Drive to Mt. Aragats which is the highest peak of Armenia (4090 m.). Hiking the southern peak 3880 m. Visit Amberd fortress on the slopes of Mt. Aragats if time permits. Return back to Yerevan. Overnight in Yerevan.

Hiking duration 5-6 hours +700, - 700 meters of ascend and descend.

Day 6: **WINE TOUR:** Yerevan – Khor Virap – Noravank – “Trinity Winery” – Yerevan

Drive to Khor Virap monastery which offers a great view to Mt . Ararat. Return back to Yerevan. Drive to Noravank monastery of 10-14 cen. which is situated in the beautiful canyon of Gnishik river. Lunch can be organized in cave café tasting simple but very tasty barbeque. Continue to Aghavnadzor village near Yeghegnadzor town to visit “Trinity” winery which is an organic winery famous for the quality of rose wine and blow-your-socks off areni wine. Tasting wine and grappa. Return back to Yerevan. Overnight in Yerevan.

Day 7: **MOTO TOUR**

Moto tour (with on road and dual sport moto: Yamaha XT660, Kawasaki KLR650) can be optional with another 4x4 tour or some classical itinerary in Armenia. One can rent the following One can also go to the southern part of Armenia to explore Tatev monastery and experience world longest aerial tramway.
